



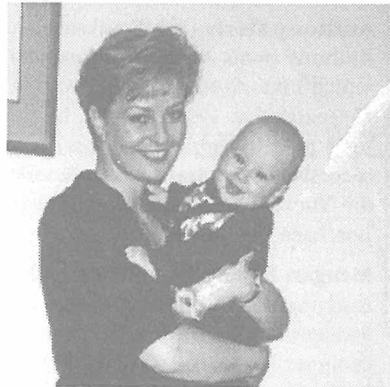
Queens Trust award for RICHARD CHENHALL

The following is an extract from the Melbourne University News, 25 August, 1995.

According to Anthropology lecturer Dr Douglas Lewis, the London school has one of the best anthropology departments in the world and includes several experts in aboriginal anthropology. Richard will look at the development of Australia as a nation and the effect that government policy has had on aboriginal communities. He has also received an Overseas Research Student Award from the United Kingdom Committee of Vice-Chancellors and Principals to help support his study.

She is currently a homemaker, exotic baker and special finishes artist (ie TV sets, restaurant frescoes, wood grain.)

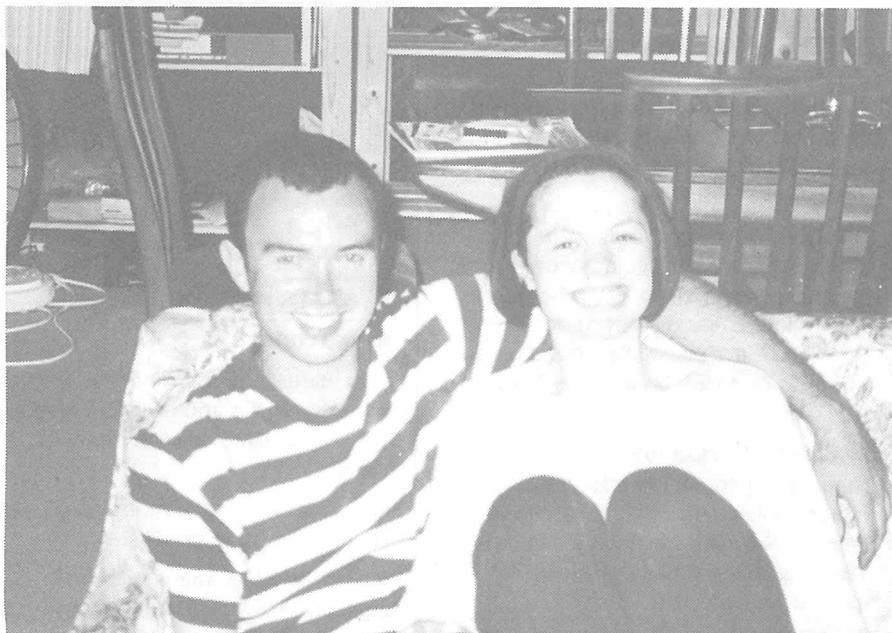
Highlight of her career: in 1990 she won a special commendation from HIA for her work.

NEW PAVILION PLANNED

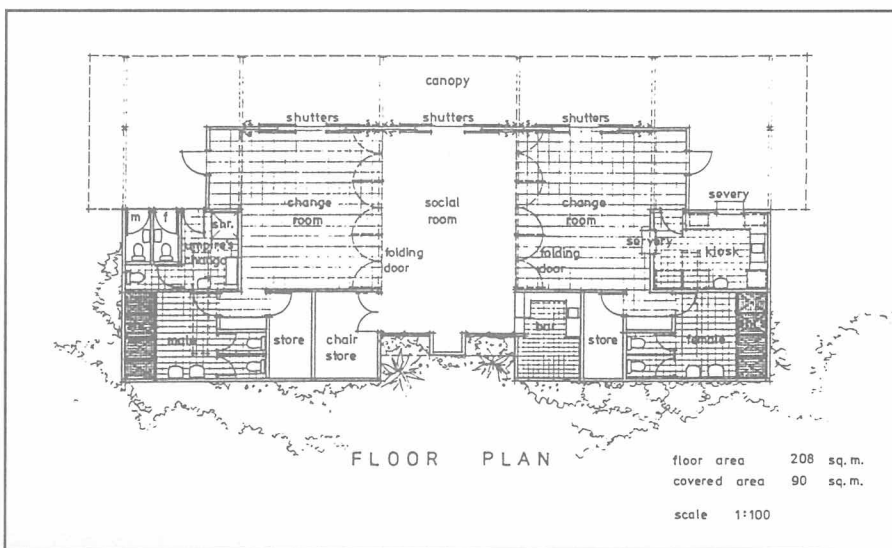
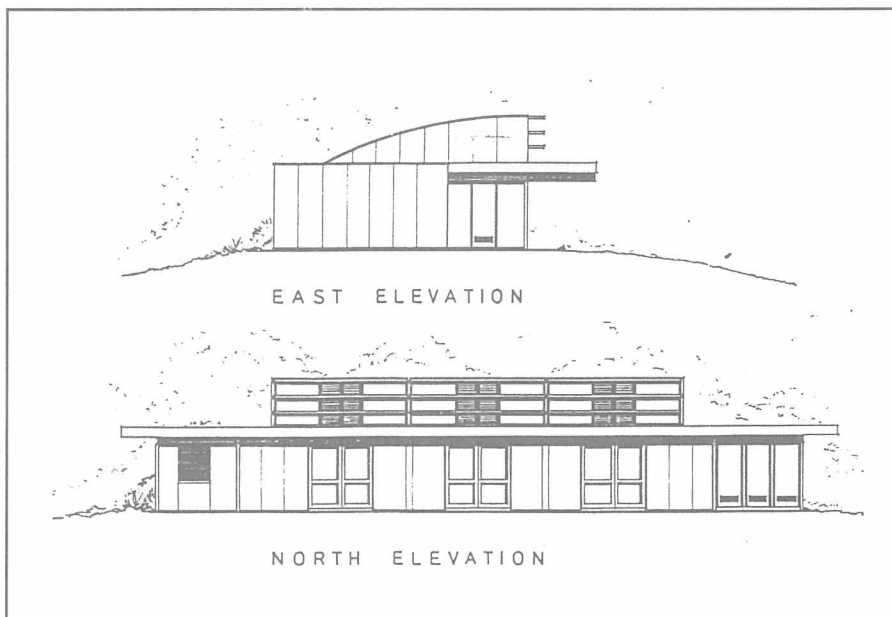
A permanent home for the EXECS
